

PREAMBLE

WILL TO SET AN EXEMPLARY POSITION

Willingness to be: concrete / pragmatic / consistent with available resources.

Willingness to support: the association is there to assist the municipality, which, as the owner of the site, is responsible for undertaking the work.

Willingness to Restore: leader the municipality (and supporting association)

Animate: leader the association (and supporting municipality) **Communicate**: joint approach (municipality and association)

Given its great age, this chapel needs to find kind souls to watch over it, allow it to continue its journey, and along the way, whatever the future holds, have people of good will to support it.

In 2005, it came close to disaster and almost didn't recover from its dilapidated state; we haven't forgotten that!

MAINTAIN ► THE STRUCTURE

- ► Monitor the aging of the infrastructure Secure the roof and surrounding walls
- Keep the chapel clean and accessible at all times
- Install a threshold at the main entrance
- ► Restore the modillions on the north façade
- ► Ensure the seal at the joint between the walls and the roof

RESTORE ► THE LIVING SPACE

- All wooden elements (sacristy, choir, and nave)
- ► All walls and floors (sacristy, choir, and nave)
- ► The canvases of the north, south, and choir altars
- ► The two large polychrome wooden statues of Saint Maclou and Saint Marcouf, the baptistery, and the confessional
- ► Equip the chapel with equipment that allows it to be opened daily from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 PM (based on the model of the Repentigny church)
- ► Equip the chapel with a heating system and a dehumidifier

DEVELOP ► THE PERIPHERY AND SURROUNDINGS

- ▶ Develop the area around the yew tree (benches, tables, etc.)
- ► Repair the severely damaged graves
- ► Create a parking area at the entrance to the orchard
- ► Provide exterior lighting for the chapel and parking lot
- Bring the cedar hedge up to standard

FOR OPTIMAL FINANCING, A CONVICTION TO SHARE!



Internal communications, address books, institutional networks, corporate lobbying, and local and regional media are all distribution channels to be used; they, in turn, provide potential funding.

Make yourself known and recognized, assure and reassure, from local to international, and be on the lookout for all opportunities.

Organize personalized lobbying communications across a range of international and local audiences.

Inventory all public and private structures and organizations committed to heritage preservation.

Convince the project and its initiators of its seriousness. Provide guarantees of transparency in fund management (open a dedicated account with Crédit Agricole de Normandie).

Commit to ensuring the fair allocation of funding, based on donors' wishes.

This restoration project is estimated to cost between €200,000 and €300,000. Please note that the restoration work carried out from 2008 to 2018 required an investment of €79,000.

FIRST STEPS

Following the presentation of this "Executive Summary," these initial steps will gradually translate this project into operational procedures, measure the feasibility of the recommendations, precisely define the scope of each stakeholder, and provide reassurance and enable future investors to position themselves.

SITUATIONAL INVENTORY (observations)

- Conduct an inventory of the intervention areas impacted by the project (outskirts, proximity, and buildings)
- First level of formalization of recommendations

RECOMMENDATIONS FILE (qualification of intentions)

- First level of recommendations based on the observations established in the inventory
- ► For each intervention area, qualification of intentions

CCTP (Special Technical Clauses)

- ► Specifications and details of the work or services to be carried out across 100% of the project
- ▶ Binding reference base for all stakeholders regarding expectations and compliance of deliverables
- Consider submitting This document is submitted to the Departmental Unit of Architecture and Heritage through the intervention of an Architect of the Buildings of France (consultant).

DCE (Business Consultation File)

➤ Composed by type of intervention and segmented by lot, this document will be used to establish calls for tenders and, for each requested contractor, to estimate the expected service.

TARGET INTERVENTION SCHEDULE IMPLEMENTATION

- Prioritization of interventions in the short, medium, and long term.
- ▶ Dependent on funding, implementation will become more precise as resources are allocated.


LOBBYING

- ► As the preliminary implementation files progress, launch the lobbying campaign:
 - Information and presentation of the project by scheduling appointments or organizing introductory meetings with potential financiers.
