Our 19th General Assembly was scheduled for April 25th at the Saint-Maclou chapel.

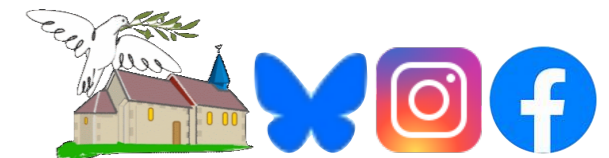
However, we are forced to postpone this date, most likely until October.
