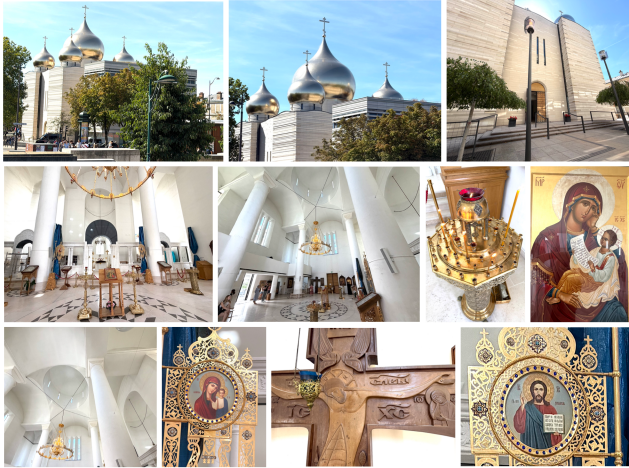

On this occasion, after a guided tour with musical accompaniment, we invite you to a welcome reception where you can sample local Norman products.

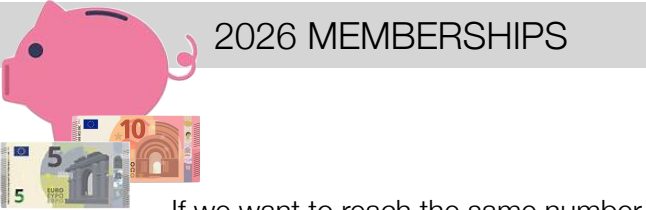
We hope many of you will join us to spend some time with us !
